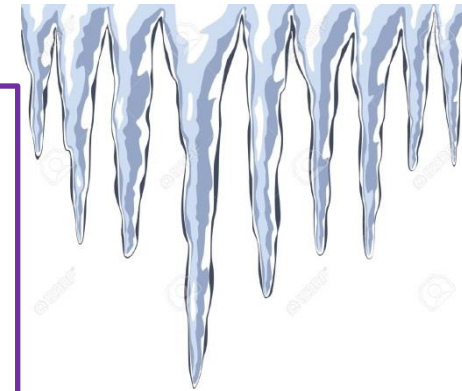


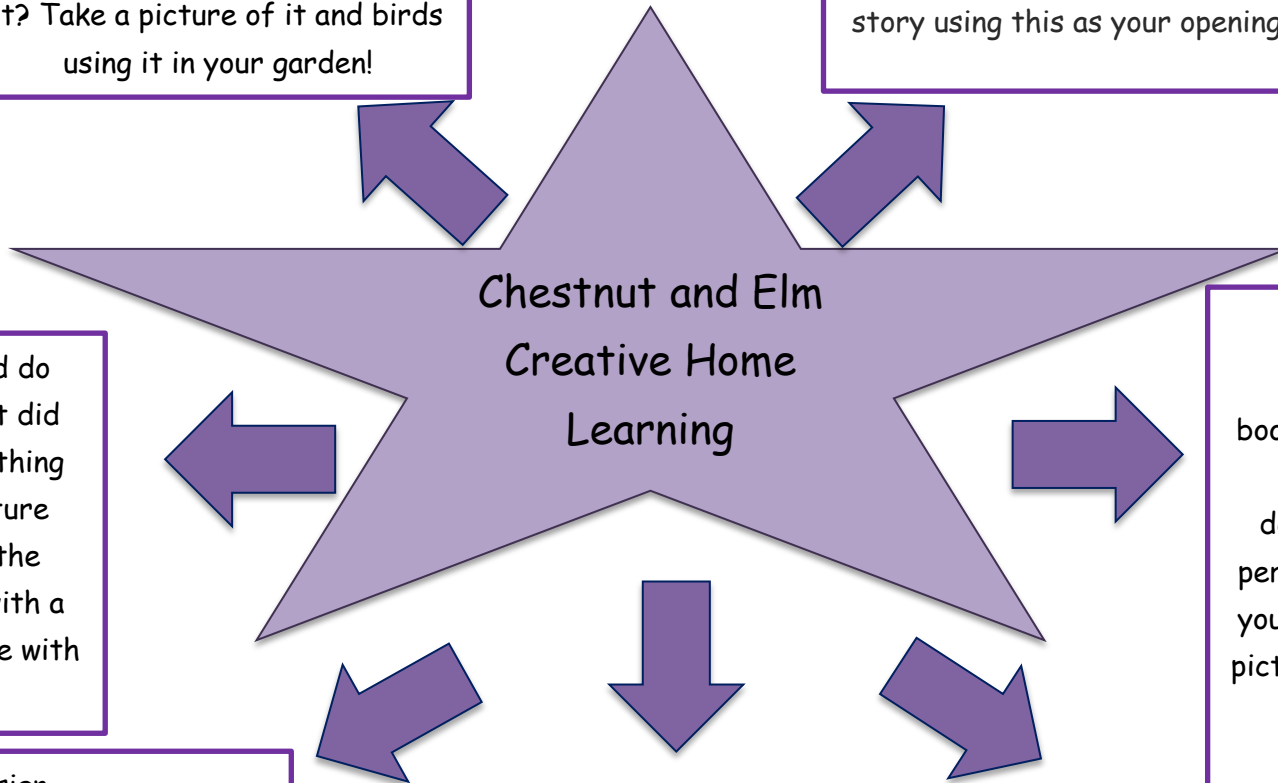


Topic: Changing Seasons: Autumn to Winter



Create your own bird feeder. What materials will you use to make it? What will you put inside? Where will you position it? Take a picture of it and birds using it in your garden!

It was the first day of the school holidays, when the great snowfall arrived...
Can you write an exciting wintery story using this as your opening?



Go down to the beach and do some beachcombing. What did you find? Driftwood? Anything else? Can you make a picture frame from it? Bring in the picture frame, complete with a photo of the beach to share with the class.

Design and make a winter bookmark. What resources will you use? A lolly stick perhaps to decorate, or a piece of card, or perhaps something else? What will you put on your book mark? Take a picture of you using your bookmark!

Snowflake design.
Design and construct your own snowflake. Perhaps you will use pipe cleaners, or cotton buds, or perhaps you will use silver foil, or white paper to cut out. Bring in your snowflake to display in the classroom!

Create your very own winter scene. Use a variety of different materials. Will you use cotton wool for the snow, or perhaps salt? What will be in your winter scene?

Research the weather in Australia over winter. How does it differ to our country? Why is this? Can you explain using power-point or another form to present your findings.
