



Parent Curriculum Overview

SPRING TERM 1 2023 ELM CLASS

ENGLISH

We will be immersing ourselves in our topic this term, using the book *How to be a Viking* to write our own narratives. We will continue to focus on our sentence structure, using clear capital letters and full stops. We will concentrate on the Year 4 National Curriculum objectives of using fronted adverbials, expanded noun phrases and direct speech in our writing. Reading continues to be a high priority. We ask you to support this by reading regularly at home and providing comments in the home school link book.

MATHEMATICS

This term we will be moving on to multiplication and division, using the column method and our knowledge of our number facts. Multiplication is a huge focus in Year 4 and, nationally, the children will be required to pass a multiplication test at the end of the year. Children are expected to know all their times tables up to 12x12. The children have been working very hard on this in school and many children have made huge progress already. Please continue to support this process by encouraging your child to access Times Tables Rockstars regularly. Their usernames and passwords are in their Home School Link Books.

PSHE

This term our PSHE theme is 'dreams and goals'. We will consider how motivation and enthusiasm helps us to achieve our goals and we will embrace the importance of challenging ourselves.

History

In our History lessons this term, we will be learning about the Vikings! This leads nicely on from our topic about the Anglo-Saxons. We will be enjoying a Viking Workshop Day to celebrate this topic too.

COMPUTING

Children will work collaboratively to design their own websites.

Art

We will be practising our drawing skills in Art this half term, using pens, pencils, chalk and charcoal. Using inspiration from the poem, *Jabberwocky*, the children will become illustrators and create their own concertina book to celebrate their work.

FRENCH

French will be taught by Mrs. Carkett this term and the children will be learning about how to hold simple conversations with each other in French. This will include asking questions and being able to answer them.

SCIENCE

In Science we will be exploring the changes in states of some materials. We will discover the differences between a gas, liquid and solid and we will be enjoying lots of experiments along the way.

PE

PE is on a Tuesday and a Friday. **Please check that your child has the correct PE kit and their shoes are the right size.** The children will be developing their gymnastics skills and football skills!

RE

This half term we will be focusing on Hinduism and the practice of this religion in Britain, exploring their values and their traditions.
