



Parent Curriculum Overview

AUTUMN TERM 2 2025 ELM CLASS

ENGLISH

In English, we will continue to focus on our sentence structure, using clear capital letters and full stops. We will also be developing our knowledge of the use of direct speech and fronted adverbials in our writing, using the book, 'Grimm's Fairy Tales' as our inspiration. We will then continue writing fiction stories to complete our Autumn Term learning in English. Reading continues to be a high priority in Year 4. We ask you to support this by reading regularly at home.

MATHEMATICS

This term we will be continuing with Addition and Subtraction, using the column method and our knowledge of our number facts. Multiplication is a huge focus in Year 4 and, nationally, the children will be required to pass a multiplication test at the end of the year. Children are expected to know all their times tables up to 12x12. The children have been working very hard on this in school and many children have made huge progress already. Please continue to support this process by encouraging your child to access Times Tables Rockstars regularly. Their usernames and passwords will be in their Spelling Books.

PSHE

This term our PSHE theme is 'Celebrating Differences'. We will think about our own values and the values of others. We will be embracing our differences and encouraging each other to be accepting, positive and respectful.

Geography and History

In Geography we will be learning about how population differs throughout Britain and why this might be the case. In History we will be continuing our learning about the Roman Empire, focusing on the continuing battles and successful emperors.

COMPUTING

The children will be learning about networking using Google Classroom. We will develop an understanding of using shared documents and how this can support digital collaboration.

DT

Our DT project this term will be to make a Christmas-themed decoration using textiles. We will be learning to cut and join fabric effectively to make a small token decoration to take home.

MUSIC

In Music, we will be practising our Christmas carols, ready to perform at the church! We will also be learning to play some notes on the glockenspiel, ready for our first glockenspiel unit in the Spring.

SCIENCE

Science is looking very exciting as we will have our first unit on Electricity. We will develop an understanding of the electrical components needed to make an electrical circuit and then we will have a go at making our own circuits. Energy Edd will also be visiting us to supplement this learning journey.

PE

PE is on a Monday and a Tuesday. **Please check that your child has the correct PE kit and their shoes are the right size.** The children will be learning how to play netball and we will be practising some dance moves in the hall!

RE

This half term we will be continuing to focus on our Christianity unit, reminding ourselves about the story of the birth of Jesus and how this story is significant to Christians.
