ENGLISH

We will be developing our interests in a variety of different genres, including an interesting information book about The Colours of History. This will lead on to us writing our own information text about a chosen colour. We will also be learning how to write a persuasive letter about a subject of our choice. Reading is extremely valuable and can improve our spellings, fluency, comprehension and vocabulary in our writing. Please support your child by reading with them regularly.

PSHE

This term our PSHE theme is, 'Changing Me'. This is our SRE (Sex and Relationships Education) unit. This will be delivered at an age-appropriate level for the children in Year 4. If you have any questions about this unit, please come to see me.

Music

This year, we have learnt how to play the recorder. For our final half term, we will be learning some lyrics to songs and having a go at collectively singing them.

French

This half term will be a consolidation of our learning this year in French and the children will continue to practise their conversational skills in this language.

PE

PE is on a Wednesday and a Thursday. **Please check that your child has the correct PE kit and their shoes are the right size.** The children will be continuing to develop their athletics skills in preparation for Sports Day!

MATHEMATICS

This term we will be learning about shape and statistics. The children will arrive back in school for their final half term and take part in the Multiplication Check in **June**. Children are expected to know all their times tables up to 12x12 by the end of Year 4 as this is so important for their Year 5 journey. The children have been working very hard on this in school and many children have made huge progress already. Their final scores will be released in their end of year reports.

Geography

We will be learning about the differing deserts of the world. This will help us to understand how environments around the world are shaped by their location.

Art

The children will be practising using their sketchbooks to hone their pencil and watercolour skills. We will be exploring landscapes and cityscapes as our inspiration.

History

Let's go on a journey through Cordoba, the city of lights! The city has historical and architectural significance, which will steer our learning. We will find out about significant people in history who have made an impact on the mosques we see in Cordoba today.

RE

We will be continuing our learning about Islam and how the tradition of Ramadan is significant for Muslims. We will find out about fasting, prayer and community work that is traditional for this religion.
